SCHOOLS & GROUPS

Arena Group additionally prescribes the following Rules and Regulations to all school groups and group bookings.

When booking for your group, please consider the age range of your skaters as we have limited amounts of skates in each size.

Please note that children between the ages of 4 and 7 are not permitted on the ice unless accompanied by a skating adult in a ratio of 1 adult to a maximum of 5 children.

Arena Group recommend that the pupil to teacher / assistant ratio is a **maximum of 10 pupils** to one teacher / assistant.

Dress for your skate! Ensure all skaters wear gloves; hats will be allowed in the event that it rains; scarves must be tucked into coats / jumpers so they do not flap around.

Arena Group also **recommends people wear long trousers or sport type bottoms. Socks must be worn** – longer ones are better. Without socks you will not be able to skate.

We advise that a **spare pair of socks** is brought in case the one skated in become wet.

It is also a great help if the pupils know their **own shoe size**.

Please ensure that all group members bring with them any prescription drugs that they may require and that all group members that require inhalers have them with them: these will be the **responsibility of the accompanying adult / teacher**.

Anyone not following the rules and regulations **will be asked to leave the ice**.

The First Aid point is clearly marked should it be needed. In the event of an injury please **notify a marshal immediately**.

Our on-ice marshals, although competent skaters, are not skating teachers / coaches. They will **assist and control** the sessions but **will not provide individual assistance**.

Arena Group **accepts no responsibility for any injuries** which might occur during the activity, except where such injury is proven to be the result of negligence on the part of Arena Group.

Lost Children – Arena Group have procedures in place with security and management on site – teachers to agree meeting point in skate area.

Adult/ Teacher Supervision – School needs to have statutory number of adults required for school trip and numbers party.

Parental Agreement – Schools are responsible for getting parental agreement prior to pupils being allowed on the Rink.

Teachers are responsible for their children at all times.
